

This information should replace the 4th paragraph on page 15 of the Foundational Plan for the nation to Perfect and Write an Everlasting Constitution.

The specific paragraph to be replaced starts with "Where in The Constitution" and ends with "payment of tax".

The new version add clarification as to the Congressional fraud of the personal income tax.

Please replace said paragraph with the following

Where in The Constitution does it designate not paying taxes as a crime ? NOWHERE. Point blank, it is illegal to force an innocent person to work for or serve another. That includes the government. The government cannot force an innocent person to serve it. In a nation with inalienable rights (meaning a right that cannot be alienated from you, that cannot be separated from you, a right that is GOD given, a right that no other being or entity has the right to deny you). In a country with this of right not even the government may trespass such a Right.

When an innocent person is forced to work for or serve another, that bound person is providing the other with their personally worked for wealth. The other, in this situation of unjust servitude, is then stealing the bound person's wealth.

Where in The Constitution is the law that says a person is required to pay a tax on the wealth they have personally produced ? Any such law would be a violation of Amendment XIII Section 1.

There is nothing in The Constitution which speaks about what punishment shall occur to an innocent person if such does not pay taxes on their personally worked for wealth. Whereas other activities are indicated as crimes deserving punishment. The authors new all about crime and dealt with it where it applied. The lack of such crime punishment information regarding taxes automatically means that within The Constitution there is no allowable law requiring the citizens of the republic states to pay a tax on the wealth they have personally produced.

Such a law would be an act of forced involuntary servitude.

The "personal income tax" is a violation of Amendment III Section 1 and an act of subversion of The Constitution. It violates the principle of oppressive taxation stated in The Declaration of Independence and is a reason why The Constitution was written to prevent such. Why the Country Was Founded to Prevent Such.
