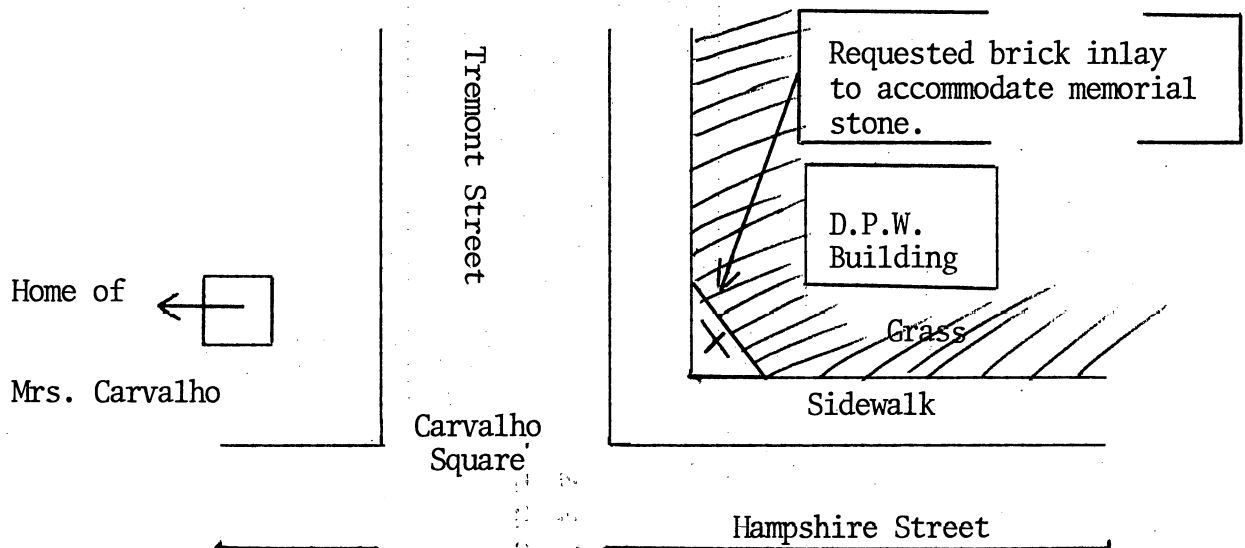

WHEREAS: The Carvalho family, at their own expense, has purchased a stone and plaque commemorating their two lost sons and brothers but now find there is no apparent place to put this memorial in Carvalho Square; therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to make a small brick inlay by the new Public Works building in order to accommodate this memorial stone in the manner diagrammed below:
