WHEREAS: These jobs used to provide employment and training for many Cambridge young people because of the nature of the blue collar work that was involved, therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to prepare an application for federal funds for training and employing our youth, in that we, more than Boston, deserve any money which might be available.
