In Common Council,

September 12th, 1893.

ORDERED,-

That Section 12 of Chapter 24 of the Revised Ordinances of 1892 is hereby amended by the addition of the following, to wit:

No street in the city which is paved with granite blocks or such material, shall be opened for the laying of pipes, drains or for any other purpose, unless the repairing of such openings shall be done by the Street Department, and the cost of such work shall in every case, be charged to and shall be paid by the person or department making such opening, and all ^xother parties other than those acting in behalf of the city, making such openings, shall before the work thereon is commenced, deposit with the City Treasurer an amount of money which may in the opinion of the Superintendent of Streets be sufficient to cover the cost of such repairing. *including any cost of repairing the ground or foundations.* ^
