That the City Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to notify and warn the voters of the Democratic and Republican Parties that a meeting of the voters of said parties will be held on Tuesday, March 8, 1988 at the voting places designated by the Election Commission, for the purpose of expressing their preference for the person to be nominated as the Presidential Candidate for the Democratic and Republican Parties; two (2) district members of the State Committee (one man and one woman) for each political party from the Suffolk and Middlesex and Middlesex and Suffolk Senatorial Districts; fifteen (15) members of the Democratic City Committee from each ward in the city; thirty-five (35) members of the Republican City Committee from each ward in the city, and it is further

ORDERED:

That the polls will be open from seven o'clock a.m. on said date until eight o'clock p.m. on said date.
