A Bill, #263, has been introduced in the Massachusetts Senate, directly concerning the Police Department of the City of Cambridge, inasmuch as its passage means the dissolving of said Police Dept. of the City of Cambridge, with all its property, into a System to be known as the Metropolitan Police Commission, be it

RESOLVED:-

Therefore, that the City Council of the City of Cambridge be and hereby is recorded as opposed to the dissolving of said Police Dept. of the City of Cambridge into a Metropolitan Police Commission, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That His Honor the Mayor be requested to take the necessary steps to oppose Senate Bill, # 263, and that a copy of this resolve be forwarded to that Committee of the Senate having this matter before it
