to call your attention to the neglect of a long needed
improvement, which was favorably passed on by the
council more than two years ago. The building of
a side walk from Rice St to the Lowell depot on
North Ave Westside. Through your kindness ~~and~~ attention
last fall a part of this work was done it being the
last work of the season, ^{and} assurance was given that
it would be carried over as unfinished work, ^{and} be the
first on the list for Spring work, which was not done.
Notwithstanding frequent request have been made to
the Supt - of streets during this year, ^{and} promises
made to complete the work it is just where it was
left last fall. All winter the children as well as others are
obliged to use the horse car track owing to mud
and snow where cars, and teams are numerous it
does seem as tho such a great necessity as this might
receive some attention particularly when we have been
asking, and pleading for over two years since
it was favorably passed on. Any assistance

will fully appreciate.
