
Dear Occupants:

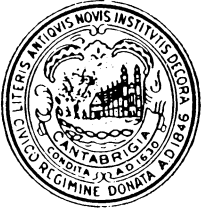
The Health Department may prohibit the exercise of any trade, occupation or practice that may result in a nuisance or a danger to the public health, by noisome and injurious odors, except at the place or places where such trades, occupations, or practices are lawfully established or which may be hereafter assigned by the Health Department.

No person shall keep within City limits in any building, or on any premises of which said person is owner or occupant any swine, horses, cows, goats, pigeons, poultry or rabbits.

Failure to comply to said rules and regulations may result in court action.

"Offensive Trades, Occupations, and Practices"

Section 1:

No person, firm or corporation shall keep or cause to be kept on premises occupied by it or them, within the limits of the City of Cambridge, any fowl, cattle, horse, pony, mule, goat, sheep, rabbit, monkey, pigeon, guinea pig, mink, chincilla, swine, without first receiving a permit from the Health Department.

Section 2:

No person shall keep, sell, kill or pluck in any building used wholly or in part as a dwelling, store, vehicle, market place, any hens, pigeons, geese, ducks, or other fowl without a permit therefore from the Health Department.

Section 3:

No person shall maintain a hen or fowl yard, or house, the nearest point of which is within one hundred feet of any dwelling, and the Health Department shall have the power to remove, or cause to be removed, any such fowl, from any place in the City, where said Health Department may deem such keeping detrimental to the health or constitute a nuisance to the neighborhood or of those passing by.
