Whether or not the rules and regulations governing the methods and frequency of making tests for determining the milk-fat or other component content of milk or cream for purposes of inspection or as a basis for payment in buying or selling and governing procedures in determining the proper basis for payment by the measuring, sampling and accepting of raw milk at dairy farms for inclusion in bulk tank trucks should be amended by striking out the rules and regulations as are contained in a document known as Special Bulletin, dated July, 1962, entitled: "The Laws, The Rules, The Regulations Pertaining To: Methods And Frequency Of Making Certain Tests For Milk-Fat Content In Milk And Cream: (G.L.
