Dear Cambridge City Council;

We the undersigned direct abutters to the Stop and Shop site on Memorial Drive wish to express our support of Governor Weld's recent order to the MDC to permit the truck exit route from the Stop and Shop site to River Street. However, since this order may not be expedited by the August 1st vote of the Cambridge City Council on the zoning petition of Charles Richards, we would appreciate your positive vote on the zoning issue with the following suggestions and recommendations:

1. As verbally agreed upon by Stop and Shop - a 25ft set-back from the property line adjacent to residential abutters (us) would be a condition for all future development . This needs to be incorporated into the Deed.
2. We recommend that the Cambridge City Council not make their vote conditional upon the MDC approval of a truck access since the rezoning primarily is intended to make the entire site conform (with the stipulation that the parcel in question be permanently restricted to 35 feet in height).

Therefore we would like to go on record in support of the proposed zoning change.
