ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to declare a full moratorium on the commencing of any new programs prior to the Council's consideration to the FY96 budget unless


1. The Manager fully and adequately notifies the affected neighborhood(s), particularly the abutters and others users of the facility under consideration,
