TO THE HONORABLE, THE CITY COUNCIL:

Please be advised that I am directly responsible to the Chief of Police in the matter of incorporations. In this respect, I am controlled completely by Chapter 180, Section 5 of the M.G.L.A.

With respect to the five corporations in question, please be advised of the following reasons:

1. MASS. ALLIANCE OF PUBLIC HOUSING TENANTS INC. and CRANBERRY WAGON, INC. to be located at 235 Broadway. These are paper locations and do not reflect the true locus of the corporations. We have gone along with CLAO in many previous instances only to find the corporations in other places without changing the locations as required by Chapter 180. They are definitely in violation of Chapter 180, Section 5.
2. THE PUBLICK THEATRE, INC., 14 Magnolia Street. There is no such street in the City of Cambridge.
3. INSTITUTE FOR ECONOMIC SECURITY INC. Please be advised that I have recently received a communication from the Secretary of State which may correct the defects in the original application.
4. GREENHOUSE INC. 1039 Mass Avenue. Please be advised that this is a large apartment building. The particular locus is a suite in said building. I am informed that they do not have permission from the owners of this building to place a corporation in this apartment.

If I can furnish you with any further information, I will be happy to do so.
