- WHEREAS:** This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Robert G. Dynan, late Cambridge native; and
- WHEREAS:** Robert attended local schools and later served his country as a member of the United States Army during the Korean Conflict, attaining the rank of Sergeant and, upon being honorably discharged, attended Northeastern University, graduating in 1957 with a degree in Engineering; and
- WHEREAS:** Robert was extremely active in political and civic affairs, and in 1985 was appointed by Governor Dukakis to be Chief of Elevator Operations, along with having served as President of the Massachusetts Elevator Association and of the Massachusetts Society of Professional Engineers and was also a member of the Cambridge Rotary Club, the Knights of Columbus and American Legion Post No. 27; and
- WHEREAS:** Robert, for many years, was employed by the F.S. Payne Company of Cambridge, where he served as Executive Vice-President until his recent retirement, at which time he formed his own company, known as Boston Cab and Door, Inc., located in Arlington; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Lorraine Dynan and to the entire Dynan family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Dynan on behalf of the entire City Council.
