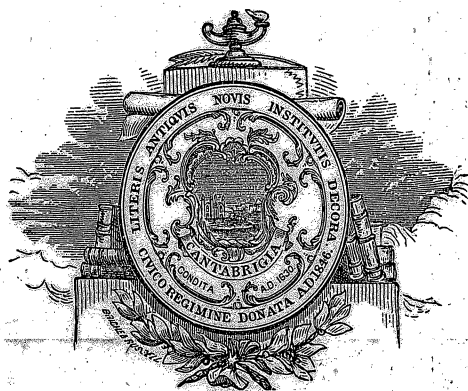


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Mayor and Aldermen, June 22, 1864

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that Main Street, from the Universall Church to Clinton Street should be widened on each side,

it is therefore hereby Ordered, that due notice be given to all the owners of land on Main Street, between said points,

that this Board intends to widen the Street before mentioned, by taking a portion of their land and laying out the same as a public street — and that Wednesday, the sixth day of July next, at 8 1/2 o'clock, P. M., is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
