- WHEREAS: Joseph A. DeGuglielmo, in a career of thirty-one years, beginning in 1937 as Assistant City Solicitor, served the University City successively as Councilman, Mayor, Chairman of the School Committee and as City Manager during the years 1967-1968; and
- WHEREAS: He carried out his duties and responsibilities in such a manner that his unusual talents were clearly reflected in constructive and lasting achievements; and
- WHEREAS: This City Council on April 25, 1983 bestowed upon him the title of Mayor Emeritus, in recognition of his contributions to the civic life of the City of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: In his passing, the members of this legislative body have lost a good friend and a wise counsellor; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council of Cambridge in regular session, assembled on this Twenty-third day of May, Nineteen-Hundred and Eighty-three, does hereby express its sincere sympathy to the family of Mayor Emeritus Joseph A.
