WHEREAS: The Attorney General's Office recently announced that they sought and received complaints against a Nashua N.H. sub-contractor, Ouellet Drywall, Inc., for allegedly failing to pay the prevailing wage and failure to provide true and accurate payroll records; and

WHEREAS: This company allegedly owes more than \$60,000 in back pay to employees for work performed; and

WHEREAS: This work was performed at the recently completed Cambridge Senior Center; and

WHEREAS: This City Council in its last term expressed its concern relative to the possible failure of either contractors and/or sub-contractors to abide by the prevailing wage law and/or other local, state and federal laws; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to report back to this City Council as to what steps had been taken to ensure compliance with state, federal and local laws on city contracted projects, such as the Senior Center and in addition to report back to this City Council as to why the incidents of alleged violations at the Senior Center's construction failed to be picked up by the City's review.
