The City Council at its special meeting of July 20, 1972 passed to be ordained a loan order in the amount of \$2,650,000 for the rehabilitation and modernization of the City Infirmery.

Councillor Duehay requested that the City Clerk notify the City Manager and Dr. Hartgering to provide the Council with copies of the specifications, the program of development for the Infirmery, the time schedule for rehabilitation and information relative to the size of the rooms, number of beds and whether or not air conditioning will be installed. The Councillor further requested that this information be ready by the next Special Meeting of the City Council.

Councillor Moncreiff further stated it was his understanding that an additional meeting of the Committee on Finance was to be held prior to final action by the City Council and that the City Manager would give them the information requested prior to final action by the Council.

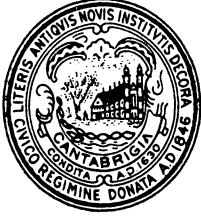

To the Honorable, the City Council:



ORDERED:

That the sum of Two Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,800,000) be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of remodeling, reconstructing or making extraordinary repairs to the Cambridge Home for the Aged and Infirm and to meet said appropriation the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) shall be raised in the 1972 tax levy, and the City Treasurer with the approval of the City Manager and the Emergency Finance Board is hereby authorized to borrow the sum of Two Million Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,650,000) at one time or from time to time under and pursuant to Chapter 44, Section 7, Clause (3A), of the General Laws as amended and supplemented and to issue bonds or notes of the City therefor, each issue of such bonds or notes to be payable in not more than ten (10) years from its date, provided that the amount hereinbefore authorized to be borrowed shall be reduced by the amount of any grant or grants of State or Federal funds received for the aforesaid project prior to the sale of such bonds or notes.

Passed to a second reading at meeting of the City Council held on June 26, 1972 and after July 9, 1972 the question may be on adoption.
