WHEREAS: The Cambridge Youth Guidance Center, an agency of the Cambridge Mental Health Association, provides much needed direct outpatient mental health services to over 700 Cantabrigians each year; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge Mental Health Association will be sponsoring its Twelfth Annual Cambridge Pops Concert on Friday, March 25th, 1994 at 8:00 p.m. in Harvard University's Memorial Hall in order to raise funds to ensure that the Cambridge Youth Guidance Center can continue to perform its mission effectively and innovatively; and

WHEREAS: In twelve short years, this exiting social and musical celebration has become a Cambridge institution; and

WHEREAS: This year, the Cambridge Pops Concert will feature classical and popular music performed by the Harvard-Radcliffe Orchestra, including performances of Mussorgskiy's *Pictures at an Exhibition*, selections from Beethoven's *Seventh Symphony*, the *Scherzo* from Prokofiev's *First Concerto*, and Strauss' *Voices of Spring Waltz*; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge Pops will include a tribute to former Mayor Alice Wolf to thank her for a lifetime dedicated to public service in Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this Cambridge City Council does hereby recognize the fine work being done by the Cambridge Youth Guidance Center on behalf of our city's most troubled families; and be it further

RESOLVED: That all residents of Cambridge are encouraged to support the Cambridge Youth Guidance Center and enjoy a fine evening of music courtesy of the Harvard-Radcliffe Orchestra by attending the Twelfth Annual Cambridge Pops Concert.
