WHEREAS: This City Council is in receipt of a communication from John Petropoulos, Parish President, and the Reverend Asterios Gerostergios, Pastor, Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, relative to its three day Annual Grecian Cultural Festival to be held on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, August 18, 19 and 20, 1989 on the Church grounds at 14 Magazine Street, Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Said communication requests permission to erect a sign on the lawn at City Hall for the purpose of announcing this year's Festival; said sign to be placed on the City Hall lawn about a month preceeding this event, from approximately July 18-August 20, 1989; and also for permission to close Magazine Street between Franklin and Auburn Streets from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during the Festival; therefore be it

ORDERED: That this City Council go on record granting permission for the above requests to the Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, with the provision that during the period of the street closing a fire lane be provided and left open for the Fire Department and any other emergency vehicles; and be it further

ORDERED: That this City Council go on record granting permission to the Saints Constantine and Helen Church for the display of a car for the sale of raffle tickets; said vehicle to be displayed alternately in the legal parking area between the Cambridgeport Savings Bank and the U.S. Trust Bank at the intersection of Massachusetts Avenue and Prospect Street in Central Square, and that the Director of Traffic and Parking be requested to take the necessary steps as appropriate to cover the traffic meter in front of the car; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to confer with the petitioner, relative to the dates the car will be displayed at the above-referenced location and also with regard to the erection of the sign on the front lawn of City Hall.

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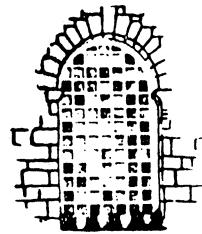

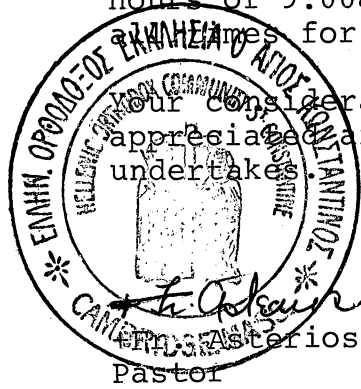
