Maximum Dimensions of Obstruction

This street must be temporarily repaired, unfinished excavations must be covered with steel plates strong enough to carry truck traffic, and all equipment and obstructions must be moved or removed so that the following number of ten foot wide travel lanes are open to traffic during times specified.

Police details are required at all times when traffic is restricted to one lane for two directions and otherwise as may be determined by the Police Department.

Other Special Provisions: Closing 100 lin. feet of Mass. Ave. sidewalk during pile driving operation, (Fri. 8/2/85) on or about Aug. 15th erect temporary protection scaffolding for 6-7 mos. on Lee St. Request area 4' into Lee St. & 20 lin. feet for temp. office trailer and erection of 'NO PARKING' signs from Mass Ave. to corner of building site.

This street blockage must be barricaded and signs and other protective devices must be installed and maintained during the entire time the street is blocked according to the standards of the DEPARTMENT OF TRAFFIC AND PARKING.

This Permit is required and issued in addition to any required license from the Cambridge Commissioner of Public Works, and is not a substitute therefor. The person accepting this permit shall conform to the Statutes of the Commonwealth, the Regulations of the Department of Traffic and Parking, the ordinances of the City of Cambridge and the conditions in this permit.

This permit may be revoked at any time by the Director of Traffic; a violation of any of its conditions shall work an immediate revocation of the permit. The person to whom this permit is issued shall indemnify and save harmless the City of Cambridge from any damage it may sustain, or be required to pay by reason of the exercise of this permit, or by reason of any act or neglect of himself or any of his employees or agents relating to the exercise of this permit or by reason of any violation of any condition of this permit.
