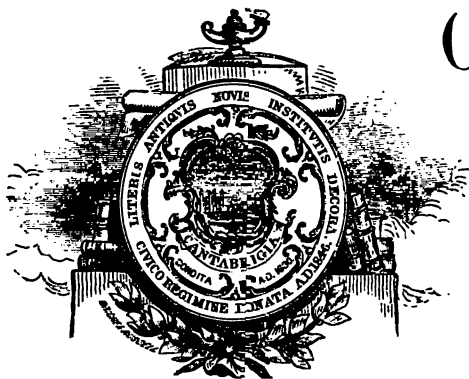




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec. 21, 1874

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Mill Street—
from De Wolf to Holyoke St.
should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *thirty five feet*
in width between *De Wolf and Holyoke Sts.*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

J. G. Chase City Engineer

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the removal
of all obstructions standing thereon,
