IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

May 29th, 1894.

Whereas: By an order of the City Council, passed December 5, 1893, certain parcels of private lands on the westerly side of Cushing street, were taken for the widening of said street and for the purpose of retaining said street on said westerly side, - damages in the sum of \$63.30 being awarded for the land so taken as aforesaid; and

Whereas: William H. Lee and Thomas H. Manton the owners of a portion of the land so taken as aforesaid, in consideration of a release by the City of Cambridge, back to them of their land, have agreed by an instrument duly executed and acknowledged to give, grant, bargain and convey to said City, its successors and assigns the right to enter upon, dig up, level and grade said land as described in said instrument of release, as the said City shall deem best and suitable to conform to the grade of the adjacent street, at any time within one year from date of said release, and thereafter as in the opinion of said City may be necessary for the proper protection of said street;—

It is therefore

Ordered,

That the Mayor be authorized to sign an instrument of release to the said William H. Lee and Thomas H. Manton of all the said land so taken by the City as aforesaid into and upon which they have given the said City the right to enter upon as aforesaid.
