Gentlemen:

At a regular meeting of the City Council held on Monday evening, November 15, 1948, the following Resolution was Ordered Accepted and Adopted : -

RESOLVED, that the City of Revere join with other communities in greater Boston which are subject to the deficiency tax in the running of the Metropolitan Transit Authority, to protest the excessive and ruinous assessment and to make efforts to arrive at a solution to relieve the burdensome and punishing deficit tax and place the responsibility on the State, which created this condition.

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be sent to His Excellency, Governor Bradford and the MTA and the cities and towns in the Metropolitan District served by the Railway.

ORDERED accepted and adopted by the City Council on Monday, November 15, 1948.
