In regard to Council Order Number 44, dated June 16, 1997
RE: a report on whether non-residents have been hired for
summer jobs at the golf course and an explanation of the
policy for informing customers of the daily reduced resident
rate, Recreation Director Paul Ryder reports the following
for your review:

Seven staff were hired at the golf course for the summer
season. Of the seven, six were Cambridge residents and four
were minorities. The hiring of the one non-resident was
based on his extensive golf course maintenance experience.

In regard to policy on informing residents of the reduced
daily rate, signs are posted at the front entrance to the
clubhouse, the Pro Shop, and at the registration desk. In
addition, all participants are informed by golf course
personnel of the reduced daily resident rate when they
register to play.

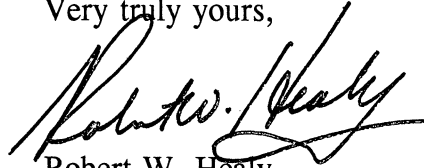
