WHEREAS: In 1972, Dorothy was appointed to teach seventh grade at the Kennedy School, where she taught until her retirement; and

WHEREAS: Whereas the citizens and especially the children of Cambridge have been enriched by the skill and service of Dorothy Walsh; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council express its appreciation to Dorothy Walsh for her thirty five years of dedicated service to the Cambridge Public Schools and wish her many years of good health and fortune during her retirement; and be it further
