- WHEREAS: Firefighter Fabianski was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant on August 24, 1952 at which time he was assigned to the Rescue Company; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Fabianski had always been a dedicated firefighter throughout his entire career in the department, being specifically commended for bravery in 1963; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Lieutenant Stanley C. Fabianski for his dedication to duty and to further extend to him our very best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
