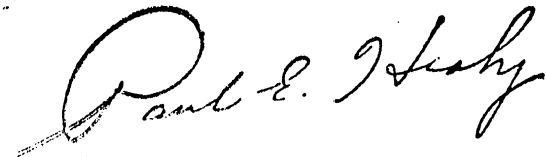


- WHEREAS: IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE MORE THAN ONE THOUSAND STUDENTS CURRENTLY RECEIVE CLASS INSTRUCTION ON ORCHESTRAL INSTRUMENTS AND AT LEAST TWELVE HUNDRED STUDENTS CURRENTLY BELONG TO VOCAL PERFORMING GROUPS WITH FEWER THAN FIVE PERCENT TAKING PRIVATE LESSONS, AND
- WHEREAS: MOST CAMBRIDGE STUDENTS CANNOT AFFORD TO RECEIVE PRIVATE LESSONS FROM THE MANY TALENTED PROFESSIONALS IN THE BOSTON AREA, AND
- WHEREAS: THERE HAS BEEN NO REAL VEHICLE TO DISSEMINATE INFORMATION CONCERNING MUSICAL OPPORTUNITIES, AND
- WHEREAS: THE FRIENDS OF MUSIC OF THE CAMBRIDGE SCHOOLS INC. WAS RECENTLY ESTABLISHED TO PROVIDE FULL OR PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIPS TO PROMISING STUDENTS FOR STUDY WITH MEMBERS OF THE BOSTON SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA AND OTHER DISTINGUISHED LOCAL PROFESSIONALS, AND
- WHEREAS: THIS ORGANIZATION WILL AVAIL STUDENTS AND PARENTS OF OPPORTUNITIES, PROGRAMS AND INFORMATION CONCERNING MUSIC IN THE BOSTON AREA, AND
- WHEREAS: THEY HAVE COMMITTED THEMSELVES TO THE ENRICHMENT AND PROLIFERATION OF MUSICAL PROGRAMMING, AND
- WHEREAS: THE FRIENDS OF MUSIC NEED OUR SUPPORT, NOW THEREFORE BE IT
- RESOLVED: THAT I, ALFRED E. VELLUCCI, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE, URGE THIS SCHOOL COMMITTEE TO SUPPORT THE FRIENDS OF MUSIC, AND BE IT FURTHER
- RESOLVED: THAT THE CITIZENS OF CAMBRIDGE ARE URGED TO SUPPORT THIS COMMENDABLE EFFORT THROUGH THEIR GENEROSITY AND TIME.

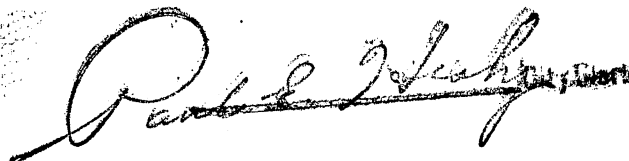
