WHEREAS: The Cambridge Camping Association is preparing for the 1991 summer season by organizing its fourth annual roadrace to take place on the 14th of April, the last day of Camping Association Week, with the proceeds of the roadrace going towards the Association's summer programs; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council urges people to participate in the roadrace and help make this a super summer season for our city's children; and further be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council acknowledges the Cambridge Camping Association for its outstanding work with Cambridge children and for serving these children with a worthy and valuable program.
