IN CITY COUNCIL

June 7, 1982

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Cambridge Peace Education Project for the erection of a banner across Massachusetts Avenue at the premises numbered 556 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, MA.

Said banner to be twenty-one feet long and thirty-six inches wide, weighing approximately eight pounds to extend over the public way at a height of twenty feet.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner, and to further gain the written approval of the owners of the buildings of which said banner will be adhered.

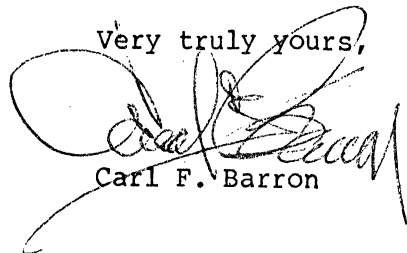

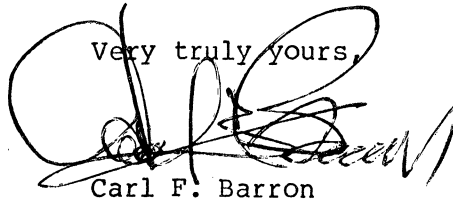
