HEARING NOTICE

D.P.U. 1720 BOSTON EDISON COMPANY

The Department of Public Utilities is investigating a request filed by Boston Edison Company on December 16, 1983 for a rate increase of \$37.5 million, or approximately 4.23% of total revenues. The requested increase would affect all classes of service.

The Department of Public Utilities will conduct two public hearings: (1) on Wednesday, January 18, 1984 in the Lower Nevins Hall, Memorial Building, Concord Square, Framingham, Massachusetts at 7:30 P.M. and (2) on Wednesday, January 25, 1984 in the Gardner Auditorium, State House, Boston, Massachusetts at 7:30 P.M.

Boston Edison Company has filed a request with the Department for a rate increase of \$37.5 million dollars. The Department has opened an investigation on its own motion into this request. Proposed schedules are: M.D.P.U. Nos. Church Rate 639 A-1; All-Electric Rate 640 A-2; Residence Rate 641-642, B & C; All-Electric Apartment House 643, C-1; Street Lighting 644 Rate E; Street Lighting, Fire Alarm and Traffic Signal Energy 645 Rate E-1; Outdoor Lighting 646 Rate F; General Service Rate 647 thru 649 G-1 thru G-3; Miscellaneous Energy 650 Rate H; Space Heating 651 Rate J; Apartment Housing 652 Rate K; Water Heating 653 Rate L; Miscellaneous Charges 654; Direct Current Rate 655; Optional Residence Time of Use 656 Rate B-4; Optional Time of Use 657 thru 661 Rate P, P-1, T-1 thru T-3; Residence Heating 662 Rate B-22; and Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment 663.

These rates were filed with the Department on December 16, 1983 to become effective January 1, 1984, but have been suspended until July 1, 1984.
