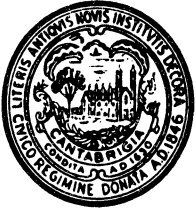

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 17, regarding the measures taken in response to the scheduling of officers assigned to traffic duty, the Chief of Police reports that two marked cruisers assigned to the Traffic Division (days) have been made available to Officers of the Impact Shift (6:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.). These Officers have been instructed by Captain Burke that between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m., these two vehicles will be assigned strictly to traffic enforcement.

Enclosed you will find a breakdown of the issuing of motor vehicle violations from January to September, 1989. Please note that traffic enforcement does not cease at 5:00 p.m. when the day traffic division tour is over. The enforcement of traffic violations is a 24 hour a day priority.
