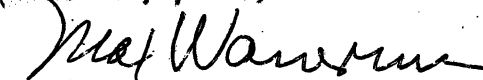

Dear Mr. Sullivan:

For the last four months referenced street has been closed because of repairs that the City of Cambridge is making to this street. As a matter of fact, it was even closed during the Christmas Holiday shopping period, and we have had severe criticism for allowing this condition to exist. For your information, the only exit we now have is on the M.D.C. Parkway, with only a right hand turn; no left hand turn is allowed, which means the people must exit the shopping center, turn right, go all the way to the circle and then come back to Concord Avenue.

Our tenants at the shopping center all complain about this situation, as they can not understand how a City such as Cambridge can allow a situation such as this to exist. May we expect a completion date on the repairs, so that the public can be notified when this street can be opened up. There is a small private way from the shopping center called Concord Lane, which could be possibly made into a one-way street from the shopping center to Concord Avenue, so that we could at least have a partial exit.
