WHEREAS: Under Joe's leadership, B.C. High posted a consistent, 20-4-2 season. Most impressive was that BC High played Division 1-A Champion Catholic Memorial three times, losing a 3-1 decision on Jan 22; tying its archrival on Feb 15th, and finally succumbing in a tight 3-1 loss in the Division 1-A state final; and

WHEREAS: Joe who was also chosen as the Globe's Division I Coach of the Year in 1990, has a career record of 116-53-21, shares the credit for his club's outstanding year with his coaching staff, among whom is his brother Bill McCabe, making it a family affair, and his dedicated team which performed consistently; now therefore be it
