COMMITTEE REPORT

The Sub-Committee on Land-Use met on October 27, 1976 in the Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m. with Councillors Graham, Clinton and Duehay present.

REPORT:

The meeting was called to order at 7:40 p.m. by Chairperson Graham. The purpose of this meeting was to show, via a model of the Riverfront, the visual impact of this strip of land if various types of zoning were permitted.

David Vickery of the Community Development Department explained the present ownership and zoning of Riverfront properties to the 20 citizens in attendance. He then constructed and reconstructed potential development sites along various zoning models so that the group would have a mental picture of the different possible zoning schemes and their impact on the Riverfront.

ACTION TAKEN:

The next meeting of this Committee was scheduled for December 15, 1976 at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers.

Residents were asked to reflect upon the visual impact of the various zoning configurations that were displayed.

At the next meeting, proposals that have already been made for the Riverfront will be discussed and a synopsis of these proposals will be sent to area residents along with the meeting notice.

A representative from the M.D.C. will be asked to attend the next meeting.
