Effective 0730 Hours, Saturday, July 31, 1999, Firefighter Arthur G. Morin retired on superannuation.

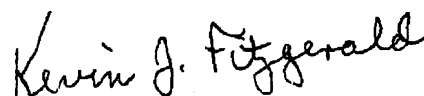

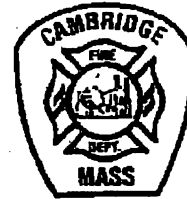
