Subject Sewer Order, rescinded.

Investigation shows that it would be quite impossible to lay a sewer on Memorial Drive, Pleasant Street, S'yly, without such sewer being laid in the roadway. The sidewalk is crowded, gas, water, electric, steam and private drain pipes being already installed. Opening the roadway presents troubles in the free movement of traffic.

The extension of the Riverside Road sewer will accomodate a larger area, more efficiently and we request that you pass an order to cover this extension of Riverside Road sewer as per a petition you will receive.

Also, will you rescind your action of Oct. 8, 1951, ordering the construction of approximately 190 feet of sewer in Memorial Drive Pleasant Street S'yly.
