- WHEREAS: During the "Great Blizzard of 78" one of our Fire Department Ladder Trucks became stuck on Magazine Street in one of the enormous drifts of snow which became so familiar to us that week; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge called upon the Maintenance Department of Harvard University to assist in extracting the fire apparatus; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Joseph Wright, a foreman in the Maintenance Department went to the scene with a payloader and was successful in freeing the apparatus from the snow drift; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Joseph Wright and his crew for helping this City during one of the worst disasters we have ever seen; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Wright on behalf of this City Council.
