Dear Sir. We would strongly urge upon you that you do what is possible to have a wider street crossing made in at an early day this season in front of our Factory No 1 Cor Main & Albany Sts. We are doing a large & growing business & have a good deal of crossing of Main St. at that point; and for passengers by horse cars, of whom we have a great many, the crossing is very much needed especially in winter. We therefore address ourselves to you personally & beg you will do all possible to have this done at once.

Would also call yr. attention to the need of gravel on sidewalk south side Main St between Albany St & Alphensis. The mud is terribly deep & thick there.

Inasmuch as the appropriations for the year 1885, have lapsed with the close of the financial year, and no new appropriation can be made until the year 1886; - and the ground being not now in a condition to lay crossings, your Committee is obliged to recommend that the petitioners have leave to withdraw.
