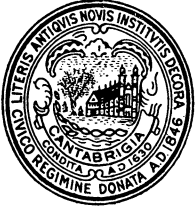

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$225.00 to reimburse Irwin L. Nolan, an employee of the Police Department for damages in this amount.

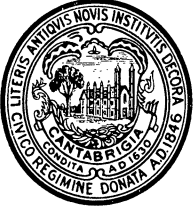
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Irwin L. Nolan in which there was a judgment of \$225.


To the Honorable, the City Council,
