That current state, county and district reimbursements formulas notwithstanding, no community in its final balance sheet, popularly known and referred to as the Cherry Sheet, shall show a net loss in payments from the State to the local community;

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDERED:

That the City Clerk do and hereby is directed to send to each member of the Legislature representing Cambridge in the Great and General Court, a copy of this order with the request that they do everything in their power to assure its adoption.
