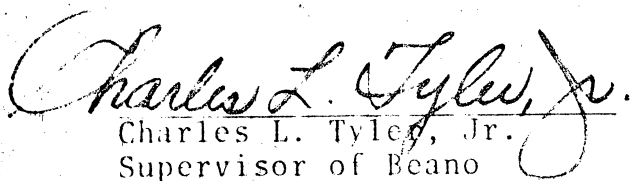
RE: RECENT CHANGES IN THE BEANO CONTROL LAW

Chapter 1165, of the Acts of 1973, will be effective on January 1, 1974, and has made the following change in the Beano Control Law. Two Beano prizes of up to \$200 in value each may be awarded on each day Beano is conducted. All other prizes for Beano games remain limited to the present \$50 each. Prizes may be in cash or merchandise.

Chapter 944, Acts of 1973, permit licenses to be granted to conduct Beano on Sunday for any continuous five hour period between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 12-midnight. The permitted hours of other days remain unchanged and licensees are still limited to conducting Beano on one day of the week.

Chapter 1002, Acts of 1973, Section 6, changes the eligibility requirements in that now if otherwise qualified, an organization need be in existence only five years prior to the date of application for license.

We anticipate the new "Charity Game" break-open tickets will be available to licensees by early February.
