RESOLVED: That it is the sense of this City Council that significant benefit would result from a "Morning of Retreat to Move Forward" at a location in Cambridge, but away from City Hall, at which retreat members of this City Council could hear and discuss the views and perspectives presented by leaders of the various Business Associations here in Cambridge as well as from the Chamber of Commerce who would be invited to be participants; and be it further

RESOLVED: That it is the sense of this City Council that His Honor, the Mayor, initiate plans immediately to host this "Morning of Retreat to Move Forward" so that it will take place in mid or late March, 1992. Further, that the City Council be advised of the event's specific date and time as soon as possible so as to assure its priority in all of our scheduling.
