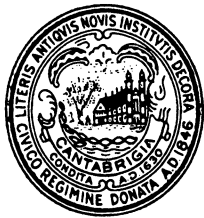
I have accepted an appointment as Director of Finance for the City of Rochester, New York. I expect to take up my duties in Rochester on April 3rd.

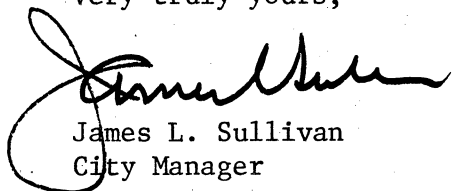
