WHEREAS: Four cases of rabies, three racoons and one skunk, have been documented in the West and North Cambridge Area; and

WHEREAS: This influx of rabies in the wild animal population according to the prediction of experts in the field, will increase in the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS: Pet owners and residents of the West and North Cambridge Area are for the most part, unaware of the precautionary steps that should be taken to keep their pets from contacting rabies, and what caution should be exercised if one should observe a sick animal; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Commissioner of Public Health and the Animal Commission notify the residents of Wards 9, 10 and 11, perhaps in co-operation with one of the utility company in their bills, about the precautions that should be exercised regarding their children and their pets.
