November 24, 1975

WHEREAS:

Angelo DeMeo, a former employee of the Public Works Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Public Works Department on April 2, 1928 and was pensioned on May 29, 1943 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 57, of the General Laws and died on August 19, 1975, having served not less than fifteen years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Lucy R. DeMeo, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it


ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 101 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Angelo DeMeo, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Lucy R. DeMeo, widow of Angelo DeMeo, of \$1,680.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.
