WHEREAS: The sidewalks of Western Avenue are often littered with refuse, creating an unsanitary appearance; and

WHEREAS: The trash and general look of Western Avenue, Cambridge side, continue to be a nuisance for residents of the Riverside community; and

WHEREAS: It is in the interest of the entire City to have all of our streets clean; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager, through the Department of Public Works, study and implement a plan to clean and to the extent possible, beautify Western Avenue; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Department of Public Works and Inspectional Services Department strictly enforce sanitary codes and take special notice of those who litter this area.
