- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that on February 11, 1986, the Faculty of Harvard Law School voted to grant tenure to Professor Susan Estrich, of Chilton Street, Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Professor Estrich, the first woman president of the Harvard Law Review and one of the few women to receive tenure at the Law School, has already demonstrated substantial legal accomplishment in her work on feminist issues, particularly including rape and the law; and
- WHEREAS: Professor Estrich has also actively worked for the Democratic Party, serving as Executive Director of its 1984 national convention platform committee; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council extend its heartfelt congratulations to Professor Susan Estrich, and wish her continued success in her important efforts; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk send a copy of this resolution to Professor Estrich on behalf of the entire City Council.
