The undersigned
would respectfully.

Report- to
your Honorable Board, that
Prospect Street- upon its easterly
side, between Austin and
~~Pros~~ Hampshire Street, is in
an unsafe condition, caused
by certain trees, being allowed
to remain, in some cases
upwards of three feet, outside
of the line of curb and
brick sidewalk. I would
therefore respectfully request
the passage of the accompanying
Order, or that- such other

action may be taken as your

best for the safety of the
travelling public upon
said street.
