ORDER OF NOTICE

Petition of Cambridge Electric Light Company, pursuant to Ch. 164, Section 72, for approval by the Department of Public Utilities of the proposed construction and use of an underground transmission line and related substation facilities in the City of Cambridge, and for a determination that locations upon, under, along or across certain boulevards or reservations in the care and control of the Metropolitan District Commission will be and are required by public convenience and necessity for wires, cables or pipes for the transmission of electricity under the provisions of Mass. 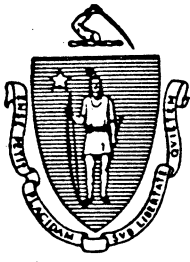
