- WHEREAS: This City Council is in receipt of a communication from John P. Petropoulos, President of the Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church relative to the their sponsorship of the Annual Road Race to be held on Sunday, March 20, 1983 at 11:00 a.m., starting at the Minute Man Statue in Lexington, thence on Massachusetts Avenue to its termination at the church parking lot at 14 Magazine Street; and
- WHEREAS: The sponsors of the race have requested approval of their petition for the cooperation of all concerned departments to protect their runners on their journey through Cambridge; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Police Department, the Traffic and Parking Department, the Recreation Department and all other city departments concerned to take the appropriate steps necessary to insure that conditions are in order for the Annual Ten Mile Road Race sponsored by the Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church to be held on Sunday, March 20, 1983.

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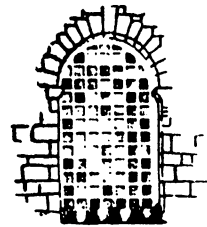

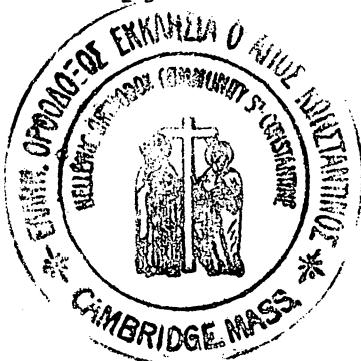
